

DOC06- MEMBERSHIP UPDATE

The Membership Strategy is a companion document to the ILC 2016-21 ILC's Strategy. It sets out three intertwined objectives of *Vibrancy, Engagement and Expansion* that –combined- help ILC make best use of its membership to achieve its goals. With regard to the third objective, *the Membership Expansion*, a targeted call was launched in 2019 to invite organisations to apply to join our coalition and in the frame of an ILC **Smart Growth**. We received **77 expressions of interest**.

Four main criteria were used to come up with a final shortlist by the Membership Committee¹: (a) *underrepresented countries*, (b) *underrepresented competencies*, (c) *regional bodies* and (d) *people organisations (Constituency-based organisations)*. As a result, **the Membership Committee therefore recommends 59 organisations for acceptance into ILC membership**.

This intake adds 9 new countries (Gambia, Georgia, Ivory Coast, Montenegro, Myanmar, Somalia, Timor Leste, Vietnam, Yemen) with more than half of incoming organisations coming from people's organisations (CBOs), directly representing land-users including women, young farmers, pastoralists, and indigenous peoples. The four regional intergovernmental organisations² that expressed interests did not finalised their applications, and are now proposed to be considered as strategic partners.

Over the last triennium 2019-2021, **four organisations withdrew** from ILC (BIOS, IALTA, PIN and PWESCR) because of a change in their mandate/interest on land issues. Besides, **one organisation** (ELCI) was terminated due to internal financial issues. For the Assembly of Members, **seven organisations are being proposed for termination** due to their inactivity over the triennium according to the Membership Engagement Index that reports such members as "Silent", and noncompliant to the ILC Charter. This is despite attempts by ILC one team to re-engage them. These are: ALLAT, CAN, GSF, MODE, SCOPE, SsULA and TRALSO). According to Article 16 of the Charter:

The AoM votes on membership termination on the basis of the recommendation of the Membership Committee, no less than three months beforehand. The recommendation for membership termination leads to immediate suspension of the membership of the concerned organisation until a final decision can be made at the subsequent AoM'.

Against these changes, and in accordance with article 16 of ILC Charter, the ILC Assembly will ratify next 19th November 2021- that ILC as a Global Alliance of **302 members** with following regional and constituency breakdown as proposed in next table
